



World Maths Championship Guide Book

Welcome

World Maths Championship is an Online Exam. Students can appear for it from anywhere, their home on a computer or a laptop or your school computer lab. There is no physical exam, so they don't need to go to any physical exam center.

Students of Grade 1 and Grade 2 can give a parent assisted exam, where parents can help them in clicking on the correct answer and with submission of exams, however do ensure answers are given by the student himself/herself.

Exam Dates: (student can opt for any one date while filling the form)

31st July 2025

18th August 2025

Time: Exam will be available for 24hrs on 31st July and 18th August (whichever date student opted), students can start anytime between those 24hrs, but once started the exam will end in its prescribed time limit of 1 hr.

Duration: 60 Minutes

Last Date of Registration: 27th July 2025 for 31st July Exam date and 17th August 2025

for 18th August Exam date

Result: Generally, the results are announced within 3 month's time of Last Exam Date

Eligibility: For Students of Grade 1-8

Exam Fee: US\$ 15

Mode of Exam: Online

Monitoring: Online proctored Exam

Number of Questions:

Grade 1 - 4: 35 Questions

Grade 5 – 8: 50 Questions

Study Material: There is no need to buy expensive books or study materials, all questions will

be coming from existing academic curriculum/books of the students. Sample paper is also

available on website. Plus we offer a mock test to students as well to get a better understanding

of the exam.

Date of Mock Test: Date of Mock Test: 20th July 2025 00:01AM to 17th August 2025

11:00PM. A Mock test will be available between these dates for students to attempt, students

can start anytime between these dates, but once started exam will end in its prescribed time

limit of 1 hr.

How the Exam will be Monitored: Remember this is an Al Proctored exam, System will

automatically terminate exam if unusual behavior is found.

What is unusual behavior in Exam?

Minimizing the browser. Resizing the browser. Opening a new tab. Opening a new program.

Taking a screenshot. (Desktop). Pressing Ctrl + C. Pressing Ctrl + V. Pressing Print Screen.

Pressing F12. Less visibility in the room. Face not clearly visible. Candidate left the seat. Side

face found. Another person found. Mobile phone found.

Type of Questions: Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs)

How to participate/register for the World Maths Championship?

Method 1. Registration done directly by Parents individually for each student. For this, plz click

on the 'Register Now' button on website to pay and Register.

You need to pay US\$ 15 per student. Once paid you will be redirected to a form, where you can

upload all student details and opt for exam date as per your choice. You will also create a

password here, which will be required to login in your exam panel. As soon as you will register,

you will get a welcome email from us, where you will get further details as well.

Method 2. <u>School can send bulk entry</u> for all students by downloading and filling their details in an excel file available on '<u>Bulk Registration for School</u>' button, and email it back to: contact@internationalspellbee.com. A combined payment link for all the students will be shared to school, which they can use to pay for all students in a single click. Once the payment is done a Registration form for students will be shared with the school, which they can send to students to fill up, choose the exam date to complete their Registration. Fee is US\$10 if there are more than 100 Students, else below 100 its US\$15.

Once the form is filled students will get a confirmation email and their account will be created. However their Username will not be active, they will be <u>able to access it after 24hrs</u>, post verification. Till then if they try to login, it will show 'username not found'

What syllabus is covered in the World Maths Championship?

World Maths Championship Organization is conducting exams at international level covering boards like Cambridge, IB, Australian Board, AQA, OCR, Edexcel etc for class 1 – 8. Students have to refer to their specific board patterns, syllabus provided by World Maths Championship is available on our website. The question pattern is of multiple choice. Grade wise syllabus is available on our website www.worldmathschampionship.com

In what pattern the World Maths Championship Examination is conducted?

For class 1st to class 8th exam duration is 60 minutes. The exam consists of two sections:

Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) + Only for Grade 3-8: Audio Based Questions(both in MCQ and Fill in the blanks form)

In how many languages the World Maths Championship Examination is conducted?

The World Maths Championship conducts exams in the English language only.

What is the qualification to take the World Maths Championship Examination?

Interested students can participate in the World Maths Championship from their respective schools or individually. Students from class 1-8 can participate in all subjects for exams. There are no other eligibility criteria.

Where will be the exam conducted? Do I have to go somewhere to attempt the exam?

No, it's an online exam, you can appear for it from anywhere, your home laptop or your school computer lab. There is no physical exam, so you don't need to go to any physical exam center.

Can I get Sample Papers OR Previous Year Question Papers of the Exam?

Students willing to explore sample question paper can visit the website under their specific class/grade page.

What are the Criteria for Ranking/Awards?

Globally, top 3 students will be awarded with Achiever's Trophy and Merit Certificate in each Grade.

- Gold medal for all students who secured above 96 percentile
- Silver Medal for all students who get percentile above 93 till 96
- Bronze Medal for all students who get percentile 90 till 93

Every participant will get detail performance report with Digital Participation Certificate in case of online exam and hard copy of certificates in case of pen and paper exam

Every participating school with more than 25 participants receives a Trophy for Academic Excellence.

The top 10 Principals, teachers and Coordinators receive Appreciation Awards.

Every participant will get detail performance report with Digital Participation Certificate

Every participating school with more than 25 participants receives a Trophy for Academic Excellence.

The top 10 Principals, teachers and Coordinators receive Appreciation Awards with Gift vouchers.

How many students can Take examination from a school?

There is no limit for minimum or maximum participation from a school.

How many times i can give Mock Test and Final Exam

You will get 1 attempt for each.

Will I get a certificate for participation even if I don't score a win?

Yes everyone gets a certificate and a detailed score card regardless of their rank.

Please note you don't get a certificate for the Mock Test, but the score card is mailed post exam to your registered email-id.

Important Instructions about Exam


(PLEASE READ CAREFULLY)

- 1. The timer has been set for the exam, and a countdown will display the remaining time. When the timer runs out, the exam will end automatically. No further action will be required after that.
- 2. You can flag any question that you want.
- 3. If you don't want to submit any of your provided answers, you can clear them. You can move forward and backward between your questions.
- 4. If you choose to drop this exam, it will not be submitted, and no result will be generated.
- 5. Once you finish the exam, you cannot resume it.

- 6. Please use only Laptop/Desktop to appear for the exam, please don't use mobile phones as few functionalities will not work on mobile phones/tabs.
- 7. Please don't close or refresh the browser during the exam, else the exam will be terminated.
- 8. Please ensure no pop-ups/updates should run in the laptop background while the student is giving the exams.
- 9. In case of a power-off or internet failure, try to resume the exam from where you have left, if in case you are unable to do so, please reach out to us on: contact@internationalspellbee.com, we will try to reinstate the exam on the same day or give you an alternative date for the exam.
- 10. There is a triangle shaped play button in case of audio questions, you need to click them to start the audio, use a headphone to listen to the audio clearly. In front of audio there are 3 dots, please use those dots to increase or decrease the speed of audio, if required.
- 11. The questions will be either in MCQ format or Fill in the blanks format.
- 12. There are few trick questions with more than one correct answer, opting for any of the correct answer will give a +1 marks
- 13. There is no -ve marking in this exam.
- 14. If any question is incorrect, please inform us via feedback form at the end of the exam. We will add marks of that question to your result if you have opted for it.

When your candidates sign in for the first time, very first page they see is dashboard. We've tried to provide easy, simple and clear interface for candidates so that they can focus on your content.




Here are the key features of the candidate site.



About taking exams (Upcoming exams)



- You can see exams available to take.
- Your exams will be visible ONLY at the start time pre defined by World Maths Championship Foundation.
- Current time has been displayed at the top right corner so that you can look for your exam accordingly.

- Your exam duration timer will start once you see the first question on the screen. You can get complete time decided by World Maths Championship Foundation.

About exam screen themes (Default)


We've provided exam screens with deep research and experience, so that you can focus on the content, not on interface.



Please have a look on the essential elements of the default exam screen.

- **1. Next Button:** To go next question, use this button.
- **2. Previous Button:** To go previous question, use this button.
- 3. Question List: You can go to any question by clicking here.
- **4. Current Question (Navigation):** Showing current question out of total questions.
- **5. Candidate & Exam Name:** Showing candidate and exam name.
- **6. Section Name:** Showing section name.
- 7. Clear Button: You can clear your response from here.
- **8. Flag Button:** You can flag (Review / Mark) question from here.

- **9. Drop Button:** You can drop (cancel) an exam, use this button. Please note that once you drop the exam, you cannot take it back, if the time duration ends.
- **10. Feedback Button:** To submit content related feedback to the World Maths Championship Foundation, use this button.(e.g. "This question has grammatical errors.")



When your exam duration is about to over and 60 seconds are remaining, the timer color will be changed like this and at the last question, you can "Finish" exam shown as above.

The color pallets on the question list (Left side) shows the status of the particular question as below:


Gray - This question is not seen yet


No pallet - This guestion has been seen and attempted

Dark Gray - This question has been seen but NOT attempted.


About exam history (results) and your score reports




At the bottom of the report page you can see the Download score card option (If the World Maths Championship Foundation has enabled it for you). You can download score card in PDF format from here




About notifications and file downloads

You can see all the **Notifications** published for you. Once you click on the notification list you can see detailed view of the specific notification.


